b. Public Comments

- 1. Paul Smith 421 E Main St, Macungie, explained the water situation on Fern Street when there is a heavy rain. He noted when it rains heavily, the water flows from Fern Street into his backyard and floods it. He noted The Borough has made attempts to correct it but have not work. President Becker suggested putting a macadam berm to which Mr. Smith agreed to. President Becker will inform Borough Manager Boehm to have Public Works put the berm along Fern Street starting about 8'-10' from the east property line.
- 2. Ralph Bartman, Jr, questioned the traffic light plan and when it was going to happen. President Becker gave an overview of the projects that will be done on Main Street. He noted the project will be done in spring when approval has been received from PennDOT and Norfolk Southern Railroad. Mr. Bartment commented about pedestrians having to cross the bridge in the street on Cotton Street being an unsafe situation. Council explained a bridge is planned to be put across the creek in the future and as for the stop signs at the bridge, it will take people time to adjust to the change of having to stop.

Council Member Schleicher noted during the final inspection of Cotton Street, Engineer Kern looked at the area and commented there was not enough room to place a stop sign due to a garage at the corner of Cotton Street and Lea Street.
