From the Mayor

This column is being written just before construction is due to commence for the first phase of “streetscape” enhancement on Main Street, with several bump-outs and a new traffic light at the Church Street intersection. We are hopeful that these engineering improvements will result in what’s called “traffic calming” – creating a stronger sense among motorists that they’re not just cruising along a state highway, but rather they’re passing through a borough’s downtown with shops and pedestrians, so they should slow down and pay closer attention.

Everyone should be aware that Council President Chris Becker deserves the lion’s share of the credit for this streetscape project including additional phases that should follow. He had the vision for it and, even more importantly, he has kept the momentum going despite lots of challenges and delays.

Speaking of challenges, our volunteer fire department has been in the news this year. Residents should be conscious that the operative word here is volunteer – thanks and credit are due to all the members of the VFD for their willingness to devote so much time and energy solely for the purpose of keeping the rest of us safe, as well as sincere best wishes as they work to build up their numbers and get their finances back in order.

As you may know, the fire department is a separate and distinct entity, not part of the Borough government. Nevertheless, kudos to Chris Becker and Council Vice President Roseann Schleicher for devoting many hours to helping bring some progress to the situation. They’ve endured a good bit of pressure and criticism from both sides, the critics and supporters of the fire department. They’ve kept their cool with no other agenda than trying to solve problems.

On a personal note, it has been an honor and a pleasure working with the borough’s police department for the last 4+ years. Besides the wear and tear of policing, it can be a grind working for a small PD that’s open 24/7/365. My thanks and appreciation to former Chief Ed Harry, current Officer-in-Charge Travis Kocher, and the rest of the men and women of the Macungie Police Department, full- and part-time, for making the mayor’s job so easy.

This will be a transitional year for the police department, with a new mayor in January and a new collective bargaining contract. I hope residents and Council will continue to support the police department and show them appreciation whenever it’s deserved.

School is back in full swing and winter is around the corner. The Macungie Police Department would like to remind motorists that when a school bus is at an intersection with red flashing lights activated, ALL traffic in ALL directions must stop and wait until the red lights are no longer flashing regardless of whether you will pass the bus or not.



During the winter months Macungie Police Department will continue to use Nixle to announce snow emergencies. Nixle registration is free and has been a valuable tool for us to get important messages to residents who are signed up. To register to receive Macungie Police messages through Nixle, simply text 18062 to 888777. Macungie Borough also uses Swift 911 to notify

residents of emergency situations. Check the Macungie Borough website for more information about Swift 911.

The Department's Facebook page is another valuable source we use to get information out to residents. On the Facebook page we will announce Coffee with a Cop events and other places residents can come and meet us. Please keep in mind if you use Facebook messenger to contact us you may experience a delay in response. If you require police assistance dial 911 immediately.

Capital Improvement Projects – Update

Construction has finally started on the **Main Street Streetscape Project**. The Marino Corporation is the construction company awarded the project. We have been waiting a long time for this project to start. Work should be completed by the end of October, weather permitting. Bumpouts and crosswalks will be installed to help pedestrians safely cross Main Street. A new lighted crosswalk will be installed at Poplar and Main Street. The traffic light at Church and Main Streets will be installed as part of this project. However, there is a 12-week delivery period from the time the light is ordered. So, the light itself won't be installed until the end of the year.

This project is completed in partnership with the Lehigh Valley Greenways Conservation Landscape. Funding was provided in part by grants from PennDOT, Lehigh Valley Chamber Foundation, Keep America Beautiful, Lehigh County Conservation District, Lehigh County Community Development Block Grant, Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Recreation and Conservation, Environmental Stewardship Fund, administered by Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor, Inc.

Recreation Update

In 2017 the Public Works Department paved the walking path from Cotton Street to Poplar Street. This will stop the trail from washing out in rain storms and make it safer for pedestrian walking. The Borough is also upgrading Brookfield Park which is located on Village Walk Drive. The Public Works Crew repaved the basketball court and installed new basketball nets. At the request of residents, the Borough also installed a paved walking path in the Park for residents to walk their dogs or children on bicycles. Future upgrades are planned for Brookfield Park in 2018.



Fall 2017 Leaf Collection Schedule - Borough of Macungie

The Borough has contracted with EMI for leaf collection in 2017. There will be no change in the collection procedure. Leaves will be collected curbside during the following weeks:

November 6th • November 13th • November 20th • November 27th

(The work schedule can change due to weather.)

DO NOT MIX GRASS CLIPPINGS, GARDEN WASTE, TREE OR SHRUB TRIMMINGS IN WITH THE LEAVES.

Leaf piles with these items in them will NOT be picked up. These items will damage the leaf vacuum, causing delays to the schedule.

Leaves should be at the curb before 7:00 AM and will be picked up when the contractor passes through. The contractor will not make special trips to pick up leaves placed at the curb after they have picked up leaves in an area. They will have to wait until the contractor makes their next round.

The Borough encourages you to bring your leaves to the newly expanded fenced area at the Borough Garage off of South Church St. You can drop off leaves any day/ any time.

Also, you can use your 2017 Yard Waste Pass to take leaves to the Emmaus Yard Waste Site.



Refuse/Recycling News

In September Borough Council awarded a new 5-year Refuse/Recycling contract to Advanced Disposal Eastern PA for once a week collection, effective November 1, 2017. Collection will remain on Monday morning. Advanced Disposal will be sending a postcard to all residents informing you of the change on contractors.

This award of this contract will reduce your annual refuse/recycling fee to \$184.32 per unit annually or \$46.08 per unit quarterly. That is a savings of \$274 over the 5-year contract per unit.

If you are a commercial entity in the Borough contract with a dumpster or toter, Waste Management will be removing their equipment with their last collection on Monday, October 30th. Advanced Disposal will be bringing their equipment in prior to November 1st.

NOTE: Refuse/Recycling collection will be collected one day later for the Christmas Holiday and New Year's Day Holiday. Put your refuse/recycling out on Monday evening for Tuesday collection on these holidays. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Recycling Toters!

The Boroughs of Macungie and Alburtis and the Township of Lower Macungie were awarded a grant to purchase new recycling toters. These toters are being distributed on a voluntary basis to single family homes at no cost to the homeowner. You may have already seen them around the Borough. The toters are being distributed on a first come first serve basis. If you wish to obtain one of these new recycling toters, please call the Borough office at 610-966-2503, Monday -Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The toters will be delivered by the Public Works Department or you can pick it up at Borough Hall during normal work hours.



Christmas Tree Collection

The Public Works Department will be collecting Christmas trees on the following dates: Tuesday, January 2nd and Monday, January 8th. Do not place the trees in plastic bags. All ornaments, lights and tinsel must be removed from the tree, otherwise it will be left at the curb. The Public Works Crew will take these trees to the Emmaus Compost Center for recycling. If you do not wish to recycle your tree, it can be placed at the curb for collection by the garbage hauler after January 8th.

How to Eliminate or Control Spotted Lanternfly Adults



If you find Spotted Lanternflies in a municipality where they are known to exist, you should try to kill them.

The most effective way to eliminate these insects is to disrupt their favorite food and hang-out. In late summer and fall, Spotted Lanternflies prefer feeding on *Ailanthus altissima*, commonly known as the "Tree of Heaven." They can be found feeding on other plants and trees, but *Ailanthus altissima* is their favorite host. Here's an excellent resource to help you identify the tree:

If you have *Ailanthus* on your property: please consider reducing the number of *Ailanthus* trees, then treat remaining "trap trees" with insecticides. This is a longer-lasting solution than simply spraying insects you see.

If you want to kill Spotted Lanternflies without controlling *Ailanthus*:

When there are only a few insects, you can kill spotted lanternflies by swatting or crushing them. For large populations, two kinds of insecticides are widely available that will kill Spotted Lanternfly adults. **Contact insecticides** kill spotted lanternflies when the chemical contacts the insect directly. **Systemic insecticides** are absorbed by the tree and kill insects feeding on it. **ALL** insecticides must be used as directed on the label. Take the time to read the label carefully and follow the directions. This increases your safety, the safety of the environment, and the effectiveness of the insecticide.

Pennsylvania law requires that pesticide labels list the site where a pesticide (such as an insecticide) may be used. In Pennsylvania, insecticide labels do not have to specifically list the targeted insect. There are insecticides labeled for use on ornamental trees and around buildings. These products are legal to use on the sites listed in order to control Spotted Lanternflies in Pennsylvania.

Penn State Extension is currently testing to determine which insecticides are most effective in controlling adult spotted lanternflies. Preliminary results show insecticides with the active ingredients *dinotefuran*, *imidacloprid*, *carbaryl*, and *bifenthrin* are effective at controlling the spotted lanternfly. Neem oil and insecticidal soap provided some control, but results varied, and insects sometimes took several days to die.

Examples listed below are some of the available insecticide products containing the most effective ingredients studied (*dinotefuran*, *imidacloprid*, *carbaryl*, and *bifenthrin*).

These insecticides have not all been tested against spotted lanternfly specifically, and additional experiments are needed to determine their efficacy.

Snow Emergency Information and Cleanup Tips

It is **ILLEGAL** to blow or shovel your snow into the street (this is a Pennsylvania State Law).

Sidewalks

Snow and ice accumulation must be removed from all sidewalks abutting the street within 24 hours after the snow has ceased to fall or the ice has formed. If the sidewalk has not been cleared, the property owners will be cited. Do not shovel snow onto the street. This makes for unsafe road conditions, and is illegal.

Handicapped Ramps

If you have a handicapped ramp in your sidewalk, you are responsible for maintaining that ramp free of ice and snow so it is accessible by pedestrians. The same rule applies to handicapped ramps that applies to sidewalk. Your assistance and cooperation is appreciated.

When a Snow Emergency is Declared

The Mayor may declare a snow emergency and ice emergency within the Borough of Macungie. Information on the existence of the emergency will be given through the following television and radio stations:

In addition to those announcements, the Borough will be utilizing the SwiftReach 911 phone notification system to notify residents on snow emergency routes. If you want to receive the phone notification, it is very important your contact information is up to date and accurate. The Police Department also posts snow emergencies on Nixel.

Snow Emergency Routes

Upon a snow or ice emergency being declared, all vehicles must be removed from the following snow emergency routes:

- Cedar Street (north side), from Church Street to Spring Street
- Church Street (east side), from Main Street to the South Borough Line
- Lea Street (east side), from Main Street to Cotton Street
- Locust Street (north side), from Church Street to the West Borough Line
- Main Street (north and south sides), from Borough line to Borough line
- Poplar Street (west side), from Main Street to Hickory Street

Designated Parking Areas

During a declared snow and ice emergency only, parking will be provided for residents at the following locations:

- Borough Hall Parking Lot
- Macungie Institute Parking Lot
- Flower Park Parking Lot

Vehicles should be removed promptly when the snow emergency is listed.

Safety Concerns

- Keep children away from the street and Borough equipment during snow removal.
- Tunneling and/or playing near the street is very dangerous. Remove all objects such as trash receptacles from in or near the street to avoid property damage during snow removal.
- Vehicles driving on a snow emergency route must be equipped with snow tires or equivalent tires or with tire chains.


Snow Removal Guidelines

Wait to clear your sidewalks and driveway until after the snow has stopped and the Borough has plowed at least one pass to widen the street.

The snow plows may make more than one pass to widen the street, therefore, to protect your driveway from being blocked, clear the snow along the road a distance of approximately 10 feet in the direction that the snow plow will approach your driveway. All of the snow you remove from this cleared area before your driveway and from the driveway itself should be piled to the right of your driveway. This will give the snow plow a place to dump most of the snow without all of it ending up in front of your driveway.

Eliminate snow piles at the driveway entrance whenever possible. High accumulations of snow will obstruct the visibility of motorists exiting your driveway and hinder the ability of on-coming motorists to see you pulling out of your driveway.

Do not shovel, blow or plow snow out onto the roads at any time. This creates a hazardous driving condition for all vehicles and is a violation of the Borough Code & PA State Law. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.





A Little Free Library at Grace Lutheran Church



Grace Lutheran now has a Little Free Library in front of the church, in the lower garden area between the front door and the parking lot entrance. A Little Free Library is a free book exchange. People of all ages are invited to take books, donate books, or both. There are no due dates for the books, and they are free for anyone to take.

This new "addition" is officially registered with Little Free Library®, a nonprofit organization that "inspires a love of reading, builds community, and sparks creativity by fostering neighborhood book exchanges around the world." (<https://littlefreelibrary.org/>) The first library was built by a Wisconsin man in 2009 as a tribute to his mother, a schoolteacher. People liked the idea, so he built more and gave them away. He partnered with another man from the University of Wisconsin, and established the name "Little Free Library" in 2010. As of 2016, there were over 50,000 registered Little Free Libraries in all 50 US states and in over 70 countries. Multiple design blueprints are available, or people may design their own.

The Little Free Library at Grace Lutheran was designed and built by Carl Stofflet to match the church building, and the funds to create it were donated in memory of Jeremy Augustine, son of Leanna and Dan Wickline. Jeremy, a member of Grace Lutheran, was a graduate of Emmaus High School and an avid reader. He served his country in the Army in Germany in the Military Police and Honor Guard. He was killed in an automobile accident in November 2014.
